2022-2023 2nd & 3rd GRADE SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST



- 1 back-pack or book-bag
- 3 composition notebooks (wide-ruled)
- 2 boxes of facial tissues
- 4 glue sticks
- 1 pencil/supply storage box (this box will store basic supplies)
- 1 small box of crayons and/or 1 small box of colored pencils
- 1 box of washable markers
- 1 small package of dry erase markers
- 3 packages of #2 pencils: at least 12 pencils per pack (**no mechanical pencils**)
- 2 large erasers (pink pearl is recommended)
- 2 small pencil sharpeners (ones that collect pencil shavings)
- 2 white one-inch binders (ensure that it has a clear plastic pocket on the front)
- 1 pair of kid-friendly scissors
- 1 basic ruler: inches and centimeters (not foldable)
- 2 packages of three-hole punched, wide-ruled, loose-leaf notebook paper
- 1 small package of post-it notes
- 1 pair of wired headphones (please do not purchase ear buds or blue-tooth compatible headphones)
- 1 water bottle
- 1 lunch box
- 2 containers of disinfecting wipes
- 1 small bottle of hand sanitizer

- *Optional: If your child would like a balance cushion for their seat, Amazon sells a number of them. For example: Prosource Fit Core Balance Disc Trainer, 14-inch Diameter with Pump for Improving Posture, Fitness, Stability.
- *Seasonal item/still optional: Do you have a washable outdoor blanket that your child could use for outdoor learning? If you do, please ensure that the blanket has a slippery texture so that it does not easily collect grass from outside. Please let me know.

Due to the need to keep our desks clean and supplies compact, please place a small assortment of colored pencils/crayons/markers, one glue stick, 8-10 sharpened pencils, one small pencil sharpener, scissors, and one large eraser in your child's pencil supply box. The remaining school supply items can be kept at home and replenished as needed or can be given to me to place in our community supply bins.
